



## ABOUT CONCERT FOR THE CURE

Concert for the Cure was established in 2006 with the desire to actively involve young Australians in fundraising exercises and awareness campaigns for breast cancer.

The group is coordinated by seven young Australians with a median age of 21-years. They have all been personally touched by breast cancer.

Since the committees inception they have held several successful concerts and fundraisers in support of the National Breast Cancer Foundation in Sydney and the Breast Cancer Network Australia in Melbourne.

## BIOGRAPHY

**2006** Concert for the Cure [CFTC] was created after Nick Vindin got together a group of his best friends to stage a one off fundraiser at a bar in Sydney in aid of breast cancer.

**2007** CFTC formed a constitution and staged three small scale events culminating in their first fundraising dinner donating \$30,000 dollars that year.

**2008** CFTC was presented with an ASTRA award for most outstanding musical production and concert of that year thanks to a special collaboration with XYZ Networks and Powderfinger, Missy Higgins, Kev Carmody and Nic Cester.

**2009** Saw the inception of the concert initiative Tickled Pink with performances from ARIA nominated Art vs Science, Triple J legends The Camera's and festival legends the Bag Raiders. The Group also added Pink on the Green and Cruising for the Cure to their annual events.

**2010** CFTC will hold four major events in 2010 including Cruise for the Cure, Tickled Pink, Pink on the Green and Carnival for the Cure. This year the committee are well on track to reach a milestone of donating **\$100,000** to breast cancer research and awareness programs.
